Parking garage discussion

On 04 June 2018, Charleston City Council voted to make **parking in all of the city's four parking garages free after 1700 (5:00 pm) on weekdays and all day on the weekends**. The four city parking garage locations are as follows:

MPB #1 McFarland Street & Dickinson Street

Close proximity to: UC Graduate School of Business, WV Junior College, Charleston Newspapers, and all downtown businesses.

MPB #2 Summers Street & Washington Street (Cinema 7)

Close proximity to: Park Place Cinema, Kanawha-Charleston Health Department, Capitol Market, and many WV State Department Offices.

MPB #5 Virginia Street & Court Street (Shanklin Garage)

Close proximity to: City Hall (adjacent to), Kanawha County Courthouse, Federal Courthouse, Four Points by Sheraton, and Town Centre Mall.

MPB #6 Summers Street

Close proximity to: Summit Conference Center, Kanawha County Public Library, and all downtown retail merchants.

Could someone enlighten me as to what are the parking-at-the-meter regulations during weekends? Is it free on Sundays, but enforced until 1800 (6:00 pm) on Saturdays. And free on legal holidays? The internet (and the city government website) has been absolutely no help to me in searching this aspect of on-the-street parking for Charleston WV.
